Academic Year 2020-21 - Prospectus & Instructions to the Applicants

Medium of Instruction

The medium of instruction and examination shall be English.

University Affiliation

All member colleges are currently affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur.

1. Applications for admission to first year B.Sc. Nursing (Academic year 2020-21) in the 4 NRI category seats at this college is being invited on the basis of this prospectus.
2. **Academic Eligibility:** To be eligible to apply for the B.Sc. Nursing course, the applicant must have completed and passed the **10 + 2 examination with 70% marks** under the Kerala State Higher Secondary Board (Kerala HSC) OR Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) OR Indian School Certificate Examination (ICSE) after a period of 12 years study, the last two years of study comprising of physics, Chemistry and Biology with English at a level not less than the core course for English as prescribed by the National Council for Educational Research and Training (NCERT).
 - All applicants must have taken courses in science subjects; ie (**Biology, Physics and Chemistry**) and **English from a recognized board/university** (HSC, VHSE, ICSE, CBSE). The candidate have secured minimum of 70% of mark in Biology, Physics and Chemistry at the Plus Two level.
 - The student who completed secondary school educational qualification or equivalent obtained from any foreign country should accredited by the respective state/country and as such approved by the Association of Indian Universities and Kerala University of Health Sciences will be eligible for admission and **Equivalency Certificate** to this effect shall be produced.

- 3. Nationality:** Candidates must be Citizens of India / children or dependents of Non Resident Indians.
- 4. Age Requirements:** Applicants should complete 17 years of age on or before 31st December 2020. No relaxation of age will be allowed.
- 5. Eligibility for admission to N.R.I. Category Seats:** According to the GO(MS) No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014, *“An Applicant who depends upon his/her Father / Mother / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) / Husband / Wife / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother / Half Brother / Half Sister / Adopted Father or Adopted Mother who is working abroad”* will only be eligible to apply in the NRI category seats.
- 6. Copy of the following documents to prove the NRI status shall be submitted:**
- A candidate, who apply for the NRI seat should submit the passport copy and Visa/Green card/OCI documents of their respective sponsors. The job of the sponsor should be mentioned in any of the documents.
 - The visa of the sponsor should be valid till the closing date of admission in respect of the medical and allied courses.
 - In case, the employment of the sponsor is not mentioned in the above documents, the candidate has to produce the employment certificate of the sponsor attested by the Embassy/Consulate authorities.
 - The certificates clearly establishing the relationship of the sponsor with the candidate shall be obtained from the revenue authorities, as per the G.O(Ms) No. 243/14/H & FWD dated 06/08/2014.
 - However, the relationship between the candidate and his/her father/mother, which are recorded in the educational certificates, maintained in the usual course of transactions by the competent authorities, shall be accepted.
 - The candidate shall produce the sworn affidavit from the sponsor in a stamp paper worth Rs. 200/-. The same shall also be notarized by the Notary Public, disclosing that the student is dependent of the sponsor and the all expenses ie. tuition fee and special fee, of the candidate for the entire course period will be borne by the sponsor.
 - All the certificates/documents required to establish NRI status/Non creamy layer/Minority etc. shall be produced at the time of submission of application itself. The certificate produced later shall not be entertained under any circumstances.
 - The above mentioned documents should submit by the selected candidates only at the time admission

7. FEE STRUCTURE: A selected applicants in NRI category is liable to pay the following fees:

Note: Apart from the schedule of fees given above, the students will be required to pay the proportionate administration/affiliation/examination fee, etc. payable to the University from time to time. Hostel & Mess fee will be charged separately.

8. Scheme of Admission:

- i. Application Form will be available in college website: www.nmcnursingcollege.ac.in (online).
 - ii. Submit the filled online application form along with scanned copies of mark list, certificates, and details of application fee of **Rs.1,000/-** remitted to college website.
(A/c No 33319732087 IFSC Code- SBIN0008652, SBI, Muvattupuzha via NEFT/RTGS)
 - iii. The last date of online submission of application form will be on 30/08/2020. Late and incomplete applications will be rejected.
 - iv. Scanned copies of the following documents shall be attached with the Application. (The originals documents will have to be submitted at the time of admission).
 - a) School Leaving Certificate (S.S.L.C.) of student establishing that the student has completed 17 years of age as on 31-12-2020.
 - b) HSCE or equivalent examination mark-sheet / pass certificate.
 - c) Proof for NRI status (**Refr. no. 6 above**).
 - d) A statement to show that the high school in which the student has studied has been accredited by the State/Country/University (**if applicable**).
 - e) Equivalence Certificate from Association of Indian Universities (**if applicable**).
 - f) Eligibility certificate from Kerala University of Health Sciences (**if applicable**).
9. As per the regulations of the University and the Regulatory Council, admissions will have to be closed by 30th October of the year of admission. After closure of admissions, the seat, if vacated, cannot be filled up. Such seats will go vacant for the entire duration of the course. Therefore, those who leave the course after the closure of admissions will have to pay liquidated damages equivalent to the tuition fees for the remaining period of the course. Any complaints in this regard shall be subject to the legal and factual scrutiny and the decision of the ASC/FRC. The colleges shall return the Certificate and TC of these students, on execution of a bond by the student along with any of his/her Parents, undertaking to pay the amount that may be ordered by the ASC/FRC or the Court of Law.

11. All students who get selected should get themselves vaccinated against Hepatitis B before admission. A certificate to the effect shall be produced at the time of admission or before commencement of the course.
12. **Code of Conduct** :Every student is required to adhere strictly to the Code of Conduct of this college.
13. **Prohibition of Ragging**

- Ragging/any type of misconduct towards any student both in the college campus or outside will be considered as criminal offence and will be immediately reported to the police. Perpetrators will not be permitted to continue their studies.
- Every student shall, at the time of admission, furnish a character certificate from the institute wherefrom he/she has passed the qualifying Examination, which would mention the status of his/her behavioural pattern especially in terms as to whether he/she has displayed persistent violent, or aggressive behaviour or any desire to harm others.
- Students and parents shall, at the time of admission, furnish an affidavit to effect that the students will not indulge in any form of ragging.

14. **Ragging is strictly prohibited.** If it is found during the admission or any time there after that the applicant has indulged in ragging in the past, admission may be refused or the student shall be expelled from the institution. Whoever commits, participate in, abets or propagate ragging within or outside the institution shall be suspended from the institution with immediate effect and the Principal shall report the matter to the civil/police authorities.

15. Without prejudice to the directions of the Nursing Councils/Government/University, the decision of Secretary, Nirmala Society for Medical Care, Nirmala Medical Centre, Muvattupuzha shall be final on all matters with regard to admission.
